# Universal Data Elements

## PH Projects: Housing Move-in Date and Project Start Date

Starting 10/1/2017

- ALL PH now using Housing Move-in Date
- ALL PH may enroll clients before move-in
  - Client meets criteria for admission
  - Client wants to be housed in the project
  - Client able to access services and housing through the project

Implementation plan

- Enrollments before 10/1/2017 - Project Start Date will be mapped to Housing Move-in Date (except for RRH projects)

# Program Specific Data Elements

## Housing Status

- Retired as of 10/1/2017
- Not currently used on any federal reporting
- If used on custom reports, will need to include on screens

## Contact Services (for PATH, CoC/RHY Street Outreach and ESG Night-by-Night Shelters)

- Moving from “Location of Contact” to “Staying on Streets, ES or SH”
- New Contact service items added and existing Contact services Retired as of 10/1/2017

**PATH** - No additional significant changes

**HOPWA** - No significant changes

# Program Specific Data Elements

## Disabling Condition Types - Dependent Fields Removed

- 'Receiving Services' and 'Documented' removed for the following Disabling Condition types:
  - Chronic Health Condition
  - Developmental Disability
  - HIV/AIDS
  - Mental Health Condition
  - Physical Disability
  - Substance Abuse

# Other Minor Changes

- Bed/Unit inventory restructured
- Client Location to be required only for Head of Household (to align with HUD data standards)
- Destination - new and edited picklist responses
- Funding Source - new, renamed and removed picklist responses
- Gender - edited picklist responses
- Many data elements renumbered
- Non-Cash Benefits types removed
- Non-Cash Benefits and Income Sources responses updated
- Type of Residence - two updated picklist responses
