Beds for men and women who are actively using drugs or alcohol. Separate beds for guests seeking active support for recovery.

Harvard Square Homeless Shelter

Short-term and extended-stay beds for men and women who are sober only. For extended-stay lottery, call at 7:30am; or 9:30pm for emergency bed. Shelter is open November 1 to April 15 only.

Salvation Army Shelter

Short-term and extended-stay beds for men who are sober only. Call first thing in the morning (7am or later) to reserve a bed.

St. Patrick's Women's Shelter

Short-term beds for women who are sober only, and extended-stay beds with case management for sober women who are also working. To reserve a bed, come to the shelter by 3pm.

Y2Y Youth Shelter

Short-term beds for youth aged 18-24 only (no gender restriction). To enter lottery for a 30-night bed, call between 8:00am and 8:45am; for a 1-night bed, call between 9:00pm and 9:30pm. Shelter is open mid-October to April 15 only.

There are also two referral-only shelters in Cambridge, operated by **Heading Home** and **First Church**; for more information, ask a case manager or other service provider.
